Last January 2018, you participated in the official launch of the European Club "Organic Food Territories" in Mouans-Sartoux. This meeting proved to be a key stepping stone towards the foundation of a dynamic and forward-looking network in the field of sustainable food, that gathers highly committed and ambitious members throughout Europe. Please find attached a summary of our fruitful exchanges, of our main points of agreement and key lines of actions.

After this founding meeting, we agreed on defining the following five core values of "Un Plus Bio" as key guidelines for our movement, which will steer our work at European level in the future:

- > Making organic food accessible to everyone
- > Building links on territories by coherent choices of catering
 - > Restoring fair relationship between catering actors
 - > Integrating environment protection in canteens' menus
- > Protecting guests' health by acting on the content of their plate.

As reminded during our discussion, we propose to organise two annual meetings of the European Club : the first one in November 2018, second in May 2019. In this context, we are very pleased to invite you to the first gathering of the European Club "Organic Food Territories" on the 6th and 7th November, in Paris.

Our meeting will take place at *La maison des Canaux* and in the *Hôtel de ville*.

Marc Tarabella, Member of the European Parliament (MEP) from Belgium, member of the Agriculture and Rural Development Committee (AGRI Committee), accepted to be our sponsor, he will be present and will close our working session by sharing with us his vision and analysis of European issues related to organic and local food policies.

Our exchanges will be conducted in French and English, the Club's working languages. You will receive further information about this two-day meeting in September.
